BILL SHAW GRANT

Chief Paquette has applied for the Bill Shaw Grant to purchase a Lucas Device that is used for chest compressions for cardiac arrest events. These units cost \$ 20,000.00 each and would be a life saving addition to our emergency responders. The grant has been increased to \$ 20,000.00.

AFG GRANT

Chief Paquette applied for the AFG grants for new radios. The cost of the project is \$68,000.00. The award process has commenced.
